Dear Parent/Caregiver,

Today the Premier announced a 7-day state-wide lock down starting at 6.00pm tonight (Tuesday, 20 July). Only the children of essential workers and vulnerable children will be able to attend Mount Barker High School during this state-wide lock down.

On Wednesday, 21 July the school will be conducting a Student Free Day to plan for the next week of learning and there will be a skeleton staff to provide supervision if required. This will not be a formal learning program.

The schools remote learning program will start from Thursday, 22 July and more details will be sent on Wednesday, 21 July. All students have been asked to take home school laptops/devices, books, and anything else they need to continue their learning from home.

More information on learning programs will be provided later this week, as we work our way through the new COVID-19 Directions.

All South Australians are making sacrifices to ensure our community remains as safe as possible. We appreciate that this is a significant undertaking for you and your family. Your child's teacher, our support staff and I are here to support you where we can.
