

2026 Stackable VET Courses

EXPRESSING AN INTEREST IN A VET COURSE

Thank you for expressing interest in undertaking a Stackable (short) VET qualification in 2026.

Please read carefully the information below, which will outline the steps you will need to undertake to formalise your enrolment in this course.

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Students are required to complete the EOI form.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Students must first complete the expression of interest form. Upon completion of the EOI form, the VET commitment to pay and training provider forms will be made available for the chosen course from the student hub.

For the courses that are part of the Adelaide Hills Student Pathways (AHSPs), you must complete the 2026 application form. Please go to the AHSPs website: https://adelaidehillsstudentpathways.com.au/form/ahsps-online-application-form



For students undertaking a Stackable VET course outside of the AHSPs alliance, such as AIE, The French Beauty Academy, Clip Joint, Queensford College, you will need to go to the relevant training provider's website and complete their application form. In this enrolment

process, please use the school's VET email dl.0783.vet@schools.sa.edu.au. This will allow us to be informed of your application.

Once you have done this and received confirmation of your acceptance into the course, please email dl.0783.vet@schools.sa.edu.au confirming the following:

- I. The name of the qualification, for example: Certificate III in Fitness, Certificate III in Music
- 2. The name of the training provider, for example: Music SA, Clip Joint, TAFE SA
- 3. The costs of the course. Include both training and consumables as separate amounts, if applicable
- 4. The delivery dates of the course, for example: every Thursday, 9.00am to 3.15pm, starting from 27 January 2026 through to 23 October 2026

All documents must be submitted to the student hub no later than **Friday**, **12 September 2025**



SUBJECTS FOR 2026

Timetables for semester 1, 2026 are usually finalised at the end of term 4, 2025. to discuss any subject withdrawals to accommodate their VET course.

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VET WITHDRAWAL

If a student withdraws from a VET course after it has begun, parents will be liable for the full amount of the course as charged by the training company. Additionally, students will miss out on SACE credits they would have gained. This will impact their SACE pattern and require additional subjects to be studied.

STACKABLE VET COSTS

The following generic costs apply to undertake a Flexible Industry Pathways VET course. The VET commitment to pay must be received to finalise ALL VET applications.

- 1. Administration fee \$150.00 Invoiced in term 1, 2026
 - * School card recipients pay only \$100.00
- 2. Course fee

Invoiced in term 1, 2026

- * School card recipients are NOT subsidised
- 3. Consumable fee Invoiced in term 1, 2026
 - * School card recipients are NOT subsidised
