

2026 Fee for Service VET Courses

EXPRESSING AN INTEREST IN A VET COURSE

Thank you for expressing interest in undertaking a Fee for Service VET qualification in 2026.

Please read carefully the information below, which will outline the steps you will need to undertake to formalise your enrolment in this course.

Students will need to complete the relevant application forms and processes for the course they are applying for.

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Students are required to complete the EOI form.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Students must first complete the expression of interest form. Upon completion of the EOI form, the VET commitment to pay will be made available from the student hub.

For students undertaking a Fee for Service VET course within the Adelaide Hills Students Pathways (AHSPs), such as Certificate III in Fitness, you will need to complete the AHSP's enrolment form. Please go to the AHSPs website to complete.

For students undertaking a Fee for Service VET course outside of the AHSPs alliance, such as Certificate III in Music at Music SA, you will need to go to the relevant training provider website and either apply online or download their application form and complete.

Once you have done this and received confirmation of your acceptance into the course, please email dl.0783.vet@schools.sa.edu.au confirming the following:

1. The name of the qualification, for example: Certificate III in Fitness, Certificate III in Music
2. The name of the training provider, for example: Music SA, Clip Joint, TAFE SA
3. The costs of the course. Include both training and consumables as separate amounts, if applicable
4. The delivery dates of the course, for example: every Thursday, 9.00am to 3.15pm, starting from 27 January 2026 through to 23 October 2026

All documents must be submitted to the student hub no later than **Friday, 12 September 2025**

INTERVIEWS

Students should be aware that some training providers and courses will require students to undertake an interview as part of the application process. Students will be notified of this directly, but should be prepared by updating their resume, finding their past school reports and work experience feedback (if applicable).

SUBJECTS FOR 2026

Timetables for semester 1, 2026 are usually finalised at the end of term 4, 2025. Upon notification of a student's acceptance into a VET course, families will be responsible for contacting Justin Saegenschnitter, Assistant Principal, Innovative Pedagogies and Curriculum, via phone 8391 1599 or email:

VET WITHDRAWAL

If a student withdraws from a VET course after it has begun, training providers will invoice the family the full amount of the course.

Additionally, students will miss out on SACE credits they would have gained. This will impact their SACE pattern and require additional subjects to be studied.

FEE FOR SERVICE VET COSTS

Fee For Service courses are not subsidised in Department for Education schools. The VET commitment to pay must be received to finalise ALL VET applications.

The following generic costs apply:

1. Administration fee \$150.00
Invoiced term 1, 2026
* School card recipients are NOT subsidised
2. Course and consumable fee
Training companies will invoice families directly
*School card recipients are NOT subsidised \
