



ACCESSING DAYMAP PARENT PORTAL

The **Daymap Parent Portal** provides families with easy access to important information about their child's schooling, including student timetables, attendance records, assessment tasks, school messages, newsletters, and school reports.

Ways to Access the Portal

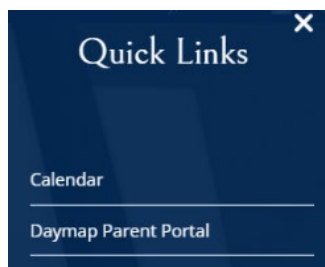
1. Via the school website

- a Navigate to <https://www.mtbhs.sa.edu.au/> using your preferred web browser (i.e. Chrome, Safari, etc).
- b **Option A:** Click the **Daymap Parent Portal** link at the **top left** of the homepage.

- c **Option B:** Click **Quick Links** on the **right side** of the page and select **Daymap Parent Portal**.



2. Via the Mobile App

- a Download **Daymap Companion** from the **Apple App Store** or **Google Play Store**.
- b Once installed, log in using your parent credentials provided by the school.
- c **If you are a new user**, you need to have registered through a web browser before you can log into the App (See below).



3. **As a new user**, you need to log in through a web browser (e.g. Chrome, Safari, etc) for the first time by following these steps

- a Open a web browser (not the Daymap App).
- b Follow the instructions in step 1 to access the parent portal and then click the **Can't access your account?** link.
- c Follow the prompts to set up your account.

4. You will be prompted to enter an email address. The email address is the same one you used to register with the school. The student code is their Daymap login and can be found on your student's timetable (it will be the first part of their email address, eg: **John.Student123**)
